## Hugh remembers some of the 'highlights' of Richard's time in Oxford.

Richard took up ringing during the mid-point of 2000 and came on our Autumn Ringing Outing to six towers in the Vale of the White Horse in the October of that year. Starting the day as a plain hunt ringer, by the end of the day he was learning to ring Grandsire Triples and Plain Bob Minor! By the time of the next outing to the Malvern Hills in the Spring of 2001 he had progressed to ringing Cambridge, and the following year on our outing to the Cotswolds he was up to London standard. As part of the band that progressed to ringing multiple method variations on the five bells at Woodeaton on the first Sunday of every month, he rang dozens of quarter peals from 2001 to 2005. He continued to be a welcome member of Branch bands that visited and rang quarters at numerous towers around the county and beyond. *Hugh Deamu*.
