Musings 'On a Carpet' - from Margaret Marsh!

There are some odd things in English bell towers! At ours, it is the carpet. After we climb the steep and narrow dogleg ladder/stairs into the ringing chamber, there it is – the St Giles Church Tower Carpet and eight ropes hanging waiting to be rung! The space is cramped with the narrow benches, ladder, clock, chairs, coat hooks and a box of old ropes. Photos and plaques hang on the thick dusty walls below exposed conduit plumbing, neon lights and a water cistern!



But it is the carpet that mesmerizes us. The original reused chancel carpet is overlaid with a patchwork of 1960's carpet. The salesman father-in-law of the brother of one of the ringers, donated multi-coloured, multi-patterned sample squares which, from time to time, the tower captain re-hammers into place. On bleak days and cold evenings the warm glow of the rich carpet is a very positive feeling. When I leave England, I will remember the carpet and the poignant experience of leaving the tower winding down the stair around the organ as the Evensong music begins... **M.M.**
