The opportunity to visit two of Oxfordshire's most attractive villages would make for a pleasant afternoon out in itself, but as might be expected the churches were equally impressive, with Sandford St Martin church having one of the finest interiors in the county, and the bells being rung from a chamber with a distinctly sloping floor. After a generous Sunday lunch at the dyed in the wool country pub of the Stag's Head in





Swalcliffe, it was off to Wroxton, which is a remarkable village at the very north tip of the county, and one of the small number of villages that appears to have barely altered since time immemorial. There is a wealth of elegant thatched housing, a lovely village pond of such clarity the fish are easily visible and a thatched hut at its centre to protect the ducks from foxes. As you will see from the photo the church looks even more photogenic in the sunny conditions. The bells of 1676, rung from the ground floor, were rehung in a new castiron frame in 1998, with the original clappers hanging on the wall. 
